General Updates/Project Updates/Grant Applications

The Township of Billings Strategic Plan Resident/Property Owner Survey is now closed. We would like to thank everyone who submitted their response. Responses will be compiled by the Consultant and will be included in developing the Township of Billings Strategic Plan, more to come in 2024!

As supported by the Township of Billings, Manitoulin Streams is working with Water's Edge Engineering Firm and Ferguson Aggregate & Construction Inc. to build an Angling Platform off of the break wall at the Small Craft Basin in downtown Kagawong. This project is expected to be completed by Spring of 2024.

Water's Edge and Ferguson Aggregate & Construction Inc. have been busy on the Kagawong River Trail removing the old damaged bridge and installing the replacement bridge. This project is now substantially complete. We would like to thank our funders from the Ontario Trillium Foundation (OTF) for funding this exciting project along the Kagawong River trail system.

H & R Noble Construction Ltd. have been busy working along Main Street, in the vicinity of the Pumhouse, stabilizing the shoreline in an effort to combat the high-water erosion experienced over the past few years. This project is now substantially complete and was funded by the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP) COVID-19 Resilience Infrastructure Stream.

The Parks, Recreation and Wellness Committee are organizing the annual Family Day Skate and Slide Event which will take place on Monday February 19th, 2023 (Family Day).
